WATA Board of Directors March Meeting cancelled March 16, 2020

WILLIAMSBURG, Virginia (March 16, 2020) The Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA) Board of Directors will meeting scheduled for 10 a.m. Wednesday, March 18, 2020 has been cancelled.

Following directives from health officials on limiting meeting sizes due to COVID-19 concerns, the meeting was cancelled.

WATA has not made decisions on the April BOD meeting. The Authority will continue to follow directives from local, state and federal officials for safety in the face of this public health crisis.
